Temporarily store items from kitchen and bathroom cabinets in another room.



Remove all garbage and recycling from the residence.



Place pets in a room with a door that is away from treatment areas or remove them from the residence on the day of treatment.

Please do not touch or disturb any traps, monitors, or stations following the service as these have been strategically placed by our pest professionals. Please be persistent in cleaning in order to maximize the success of your service.
